

Pedestrian Safety - Walking to and from School

1. Look in all directions when crossing a road. Pay attention while crossing. Stay 'VIGILANT' and 'AWARE'.
2. For safety the use of iPods, MP3 players and portable music devices is discouraged while crossing a road.
3. Stick to footpaths; do not walk on the road if unnecessary.
4. Cross in appropriate and designated areas.
 - Serviced crosswalk with traffic warden
 - Pedestrian crossings
 - Zebra crossing
 - Pedestrian overpass
 - Traffic light crossings

Students: Please **DO NOT** walk on the school access **ROAD**; this is for cars. Please use the footpaths to enter and exit the school safely.

Riding Safety - Riding to and from School

This includes: Bicycles, skateboards and scooters (not motorised).

1. By law students are required to wear a helmet.
2. For safety the use of iPods, MP3 players or portable music devices is discouraged while riding.
3. Keep left on the footpath and give way to pedestrians.
4. Upon entry into school grounds dismount equipment and store immediately in bike storage compounds.

School Commitment on Road Safety

Our School Road Safety Guidelines are consistent with the Principles for *School Road Safety Education*. The guidelines promote a whole-school approach to road safety, where school staff, parents, students and the wider community encourage safer road use and work together to establish and maintain a safe road environment. Our guidelines have been developed to address road safety in a caring and consistent manner within John Tonkin College.



Vehicle Safety Driving to School

- One way road.
- **Parking your vehicle:** Please enter from Gibla Street and continue past the drop-off and pick-up zone and into the end car park.
Or
Park in the alternative parking near the ovals to the West of the school.
- **Drop-off or pick-up:** please drive through the entrance gates and continue driving until you reach the drop-off/ pick-up zone. Please remain in your vehicle and continue on as soon as possible.
- If there is a queue please wait patiently keeping in a single lane to the left to allow others to pass.
- Do not drop students off or pick them up until you get to the appropriate area to avoid injuries and congestion.
- The speed limit is **5km/hr** unless otherwise indicated.
- Follow **road rules** at all times. This includes whilst using school areas.
