

Dear Year 7 Parent / Guardian,



Welcome to the 2018 school year!

This letter is to assist you with the start of the year, particularly for those of you who are first time parents/guardians to JTC.

I am sure that most of you are used to taking in all of the materials on the booklist on the first day. Great news – this is not necessary! This is what your child should have in their bag on the first day:

- Pencil case with pens, pencils, ruler etc
- Calculator
- Binder with binder books and spare lined paper
- Water bottle and lunchbox

Year 7s will be taught how to manage their binders and ensure that they come with correct materials each day depending what is on their timetable. All other materials on the booklist should stay at home until they are needed. Students will be issued with their JTC School Diary within the first week.

All students should be in full JTC uniform. Please note that the faction/sports shirt is not to be worn to school unless your child has PE at the start of the day. Your child should have the PE shirt in their bag on the day of PE to change into. Some items at Hot Klobba need to be embroidered as they are purchased, so don't leave shopping to the last minute.
